Dr Joseph Morrow CBE QC DL LLD, an advocate and former solicitor, has been Lord Lyon King of Arms since 2014.

He has for over 35 years been actively involved in the community and civic life in Dundee, having been a Dundee Councillor, a Justice of the Peace, and the first chair of the Waterfront Development Board in Dundee.

He is currently President of the Mental Health Tribunal for Scotland, Chancellor of the Diocese of Brechin, and Vice Lord Lieutenant of the City of Dundee.

Dr Morrow is a regular lecturer at university courses on mental health and related issues. His most recent article 'Mental Health Tribunal for Scotland – A Therapeutic Approach' was published in the *Juridical Review*. His personal interests include heraldry and rearing rare breed sheep.



The Lord Lyon King of Arms is one of the Great Officers of State in Scotland, and serves as the judge of the Court of the Lord Lyon, founded in 1537, which regulates Scottish heraldry and can order coats of arms to be removed and destroyed if they are displayed without proper authorisation.

There is scarcely a church or a civic building in Fife or Scotland without heraldry, and this is a golden opportunity to learn to understand better the language of heraldry.
