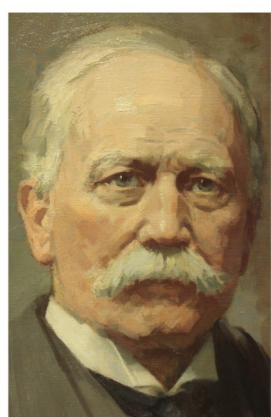

Our new season of talks and visits

The new season of Falkland Society meetings starts on Wednesday 30 October. From March 2025 we revert to face-to-face meetings and visits, some of them hybrid (online as well as in person).

Our first online meeting of the new season is at 7 p.m. on Wednesday 30 October, when our Chair, **Dr Peter Burman**, will be talking about **Robert Rowand Anderson** (1834–1921) who has been described as “Scotland’s Premier Architect”: best known for transforming the Edinburgh skyline with magnificent buildings such as the National Portrait Gallery, the McEwan Hall and the dome of Old College. A little further afield is the stunning Mount Stuart House on the Isle of Bute, created for John Patrick Crichton Stuart, third Marquess of Bute.
